Ashill Parish Council

Minutes of the meeting of the Parish Council held on Monday 4 September 2017 in Ashill Village Hall at 7.30 pm

Present: Cllrs H Hewson (Chairman), R Abel, C Criddle, K Lyons, R Perryman, Mrs J Davidson (Clerk), County/District Cllr L Vijeh and 3 members of the public (Mr C Slow, Mr D Boggon (planning agent) & Mr C Downing.

39/17 Apologies

It was resolved for apologies with reasons given to be noted from Cllr Lang and Cllr Knight.

40/17 Declarations of Interest/Dispensation Requests

None.

41/17 Minutes

It was resolved for the minutes of the meeting held on 7 August 2017 to be signed as a true record

42/17 Public Participation

- Mr Slow brought attention to damage which had been caused a few weeks ago to the side of the bus shelter which is located opposite the Square & Compass Inn. Mr Slow speculated that the appearance of the damage looked like it could have been caused by a contractor working in the area. However this could not be certain as the incident had not been witnessed and had only been noticed after it had happened.
- Mr Slow spoke of his planning application -16/03294/FUL and the reasons as to why he wished to change the proposed access from Wood Road to Windmill Hill of planning permission 16/05090/FUL. Mr Slow considered that access from Windmill Hill would be a much more safe and sensible option than access from Wood Road where traffic travels at speed. The site already has gateway access from Windmill Hill and historically there has been gateway access. The hedge which had been growing within the curtilage of the site, adjacent to Windmill Hill, has already been removed. Mr Slow stated he had been completely within his rights to have removed a hedge which had been growing on his own private property.
- Mr Downing spoke of planning application -16/03294/FUL he was of the opinion that the previous plans 16/05090/FUL had provided for the privacy and protected the amenity of the properties opposite on the north side of Windmill Hill. Mr Downing also expressed concerns regarding a possible increase of traffic movements and turning to access what would be the only driveway in this area of the south side of Windmill Hill.
- The August Ilminster Division County/ District Coun cillor Report was received and noted. Cllr Vijeh also advised she has the opportunity to be able to submit two small improvement schemes this year and the deadline for submissions is the end of October. There is also an opportunity for Parishes to be able to purchase their own Speed Indicator Device.

43/17 Planning

i) The following planning application which had been submitted to SSDC since the last meeting was received and considered:

Proposal	Application to vary conditions 02 (approved plans) and 05 (proposed access) of planning permission 16/05090/FUL to change access from Wood Road to Windmill Hill
Location	Paddock Adjoining Square & Compass Public House, Windmill Hill, Ashill.

The Parish Council compared the proposal to change the access to be from Windmill Hill with the planning permission -16/05090/FUL – which had been granted for the access to be from Wood Road. The proposal for the access to be from Wood Road, adjacent to the open frontage of the Square and Compass Inn, was considered to not impact on this area of the streetscene of Wood Road. The Parish Council was disappointed by the proposal to create an access from Windmill Hill as it necessitated the removal of a significant length of the hedgerow. This was considered to be out of character and intrusive, in the context of the more rural landscape of the Windmill Hill boundary of the site, and would impact on the residential and visual amenity for the properties which are located on the north side of the lane. As Windmill Hill is a narrow lane there were also concerns regarding the impact on highway safety which could be caused by the introduction of a site entrance, where there are currently none, in this area of the lane. There also appeared to be insufficient information regarding visibility at the nearby Windmill Hill/Wood Road junction, and the proposed new point of access, to demonstrate that the proposal would not adversely affect highway safety. Therefore the Parish Council wished to make the request that Highways are fully consulted regarding these highway safety concerns.
